HANDLING YOUR PLAYSTATION 2 FORMAT DISC:

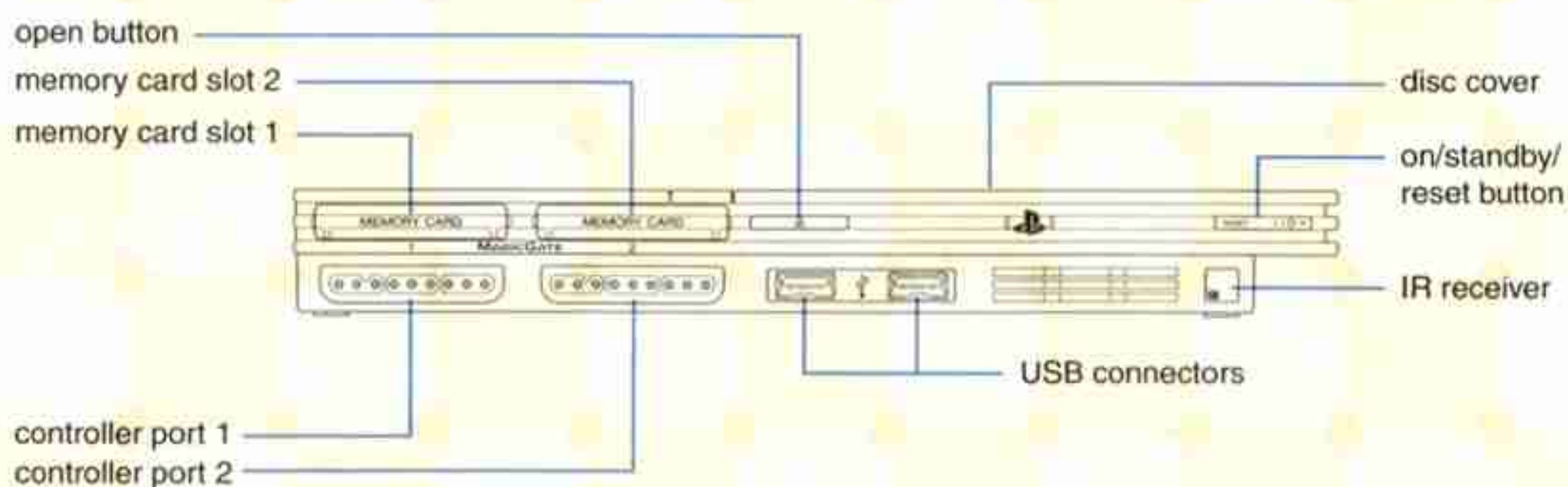
- This disc is intended for use only with PlayStation 2 consoles with the NTSC U/C designation.
- Do not bend it, crush it or submerge it in liquids.
- Do not leave it in direct sunlight or near a radiator or other source of heat.
- Be sure to take an occasional rest break during extended play.
- Keep this compact disc clean. Always hold the disc by the edges and keep it in its protective case when not in use. Clean the disc with a lint-free, soft, dry cloth, wiping in straight lines from center to outer edge. Never use solvents or abrasive cleaners.

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GETTING STARTED



Set up your PlayStation®2 computer entertainment system according to the instructions supplied with your system. Check that the system is turned on (the on/standby indicator is green). Insert the Disney • Pixar *Ratatouille* disc in the system with the label side facing up. Attach game controllers and other peripherals as appropriate. Follow the on-screen instructions and refer to this manual for information on using the software.

Memory Card (8MB)(for PlayStation®2)

To save game settings and progress, insert a memory card (8MB)(for PlayStation®2) into MEMORY CARD slot 1 of your PlayStation®2 system. You can load saved game data from the same memory card or any memory card (8MB)(for PlayStation®2) containing previously saved games.

THE STORY SO FAR

Remy, a French rat with an acute sense of smell and taste, and an uncharacteristic appreciation for fine cuisine, is tired of the same old garbage. Different from the rest of the pack, he dreams of becoming a great chef, just like his idol, the late Auguste Gusteau, whose "Anyone Can Cook" cookbook has been his only lifeline to the fine culinary world. However, since a rat's daily life is composed mostly of stealing trash and trying to avoid humans who invariably want to kill them, he doesn't have a rat's chance of achieving his impossible dream.

Driven by his passion for cooking, Remy's ambitions to become a chef move one step closer to reality when he accidentally uproots his family from the French countryside. Separated from the other in a frenzied departure, he is washed up in the sewer under the streets of Paris, where fortune has dropped him beneath the namesake restaurant of his culinary hero, Gusteau.

After watching Linguini, Gusteau's hapless garbage boy, unsuccessfully attempt to remake a pot of soup that he has spilled, Remy furtively fixes the soup himself. When the dish is a hit, Linguini implores the little rat to help him cook it again. The two begin a peculiar but wildly successful "ghost-cooking" relationship, and Remy's culinary genius is finally given a chance to shine.

Remy finds himself torn between his calling and passion in life or returning forever to his previous existence as a rat. He learns the truth about friendship, family and having no choice but to be who he really is, a rat who wants to be a chef. In the words of his idol Gusteau: "Anyone can cook. But to be great... you must be fearless!"

THE GAME SCREEN



1. HEALTH METER: Located in the lower left-hand corner of the screen, the Health Meter shows your current health. Completing the missions of the game can increase the number of health slots available to Remy.

2. TOKEN COUNTER: Located in the upper-left portion of the screen, this counter shows the remaining items to be collected.

3. TIMER/DETECTION GAUGE: Located in the bottom-right portion of the screen, this shows the time remaining or time elapsed, depending on the mission / mini-game.

ITEMS



CHILI BOMB

This hot sauce packs quite a punch. Pick it up and see if you can use it to clear whatever's blocking your path.



RAT BALL

Use the Rat Ball to get to areas blocked off by pesky critters.



RATAPULT

Use the Ratapult to get to high places.



SMALL BLUE BOX

This box can be destroyed with a tail swipe, spoons, or Chili Bombs. These boxes contain Stars.



MEDIUM BLUE BOX

This box can be destroyed with a spoon and contains Stars.



BIG BLUE BOX

This box can only be destroyed by a Chili Bomb's blast and contains Stars.



GLIDE UMBRELLA

Use this item to glide down and land safely on lower platforms.



PIECE OF CHEESE

This helpful pickup fills one empty slot on your health bar.



FULL CHEESE

Wow! These fill your health up completely.



STARS

Every level has 100 Stars in it. You can earn extra points towards purchasing items in Gusteau's shop if you collect all of these.



MINI-GAME MARKER

Move to one of these to activate a mini-game.



COOKING STATION MARKER

Move over one of these to activate a cooking station.

OPTIONS

GAME SOUND CREDITS VIDEO

Turn Vibration On / Off or Invert the Camera control.
Adjust the voices, music and sound effects volume up or down.
View the names of the people who worked on this game.
Select your TV's aspect ratio and adjust your screen either horizontally or vertically.

DIFFICULTY

Select between Very Easy, Easy, Medium, Hard, or Nightmare difficulty setting. The Very Easy and Nightmare difficulty settings need to be unlocked in Gusteau's Shop before they can be selected.

PROFILE

Create, Save, or Load your profile that keeps track of your saved games.

EXTRAS

GUSTEAU'S SHOP

Each time you complete a section of the game you earn Gusteau Points that can be spent in Gusteau's Shop. You can use those credits to unlock Secrets, Movies, Bonus Art, Concept Art, buy new levels, and new Game Modes.

SINGLE PLAYER MINI-GAMES

Unlock these single player mini-games by purchasing them from the Gusteau Shop.

Dream Worlds: Replay the dreamworlds you have completed in the main game.
Can you beat your best time?

Cooking Stations: Test your cooking skills again in these timed challenges.

Slides: Replay the pipe slides and try to beat your best time.

MULTIPLAYER MINI-GAMES

As you play through the single-player game, you can unlock 2-player mini-games that can be accessed here.

Rat Race: It's a race through the Paris Sewers! Can you finish first?

Last Rat Standing: How long can you stay on top of the platform? Play this mini-game to find out.

Tight Rope Chaos: If you thought balancing on a tight rope was hard enough, wait until you try this out!

Closet Collection: Collect more items than your opponent!

CHAMPIONSHIP MODE

The Championship mode allows you to confront up to three opponents through a series of different levels. Each player takes turns and their high scores are saved. This mode and the sub-championships are unlockables in the Gusteau Shop.

Cooking Stations Championship

Challenge each other in 8 different cooking mini-games to see who is the best cook.

Slides Championship

Challenge each other in 4 different slide mini-games to see who is the fastest Rat down the slides.

Dream World Championship

Challenge each other in 10 different Dreamworld missions to see who can get through in the fastest time.

Combo Championship

Challenge each other in all the mini-games found in the game.

Press the  button at any time during the game to Pause the action and bring up the following menu. Use the left analog stick or directional buttons to move up and down the menu. Press the  button to select that option.

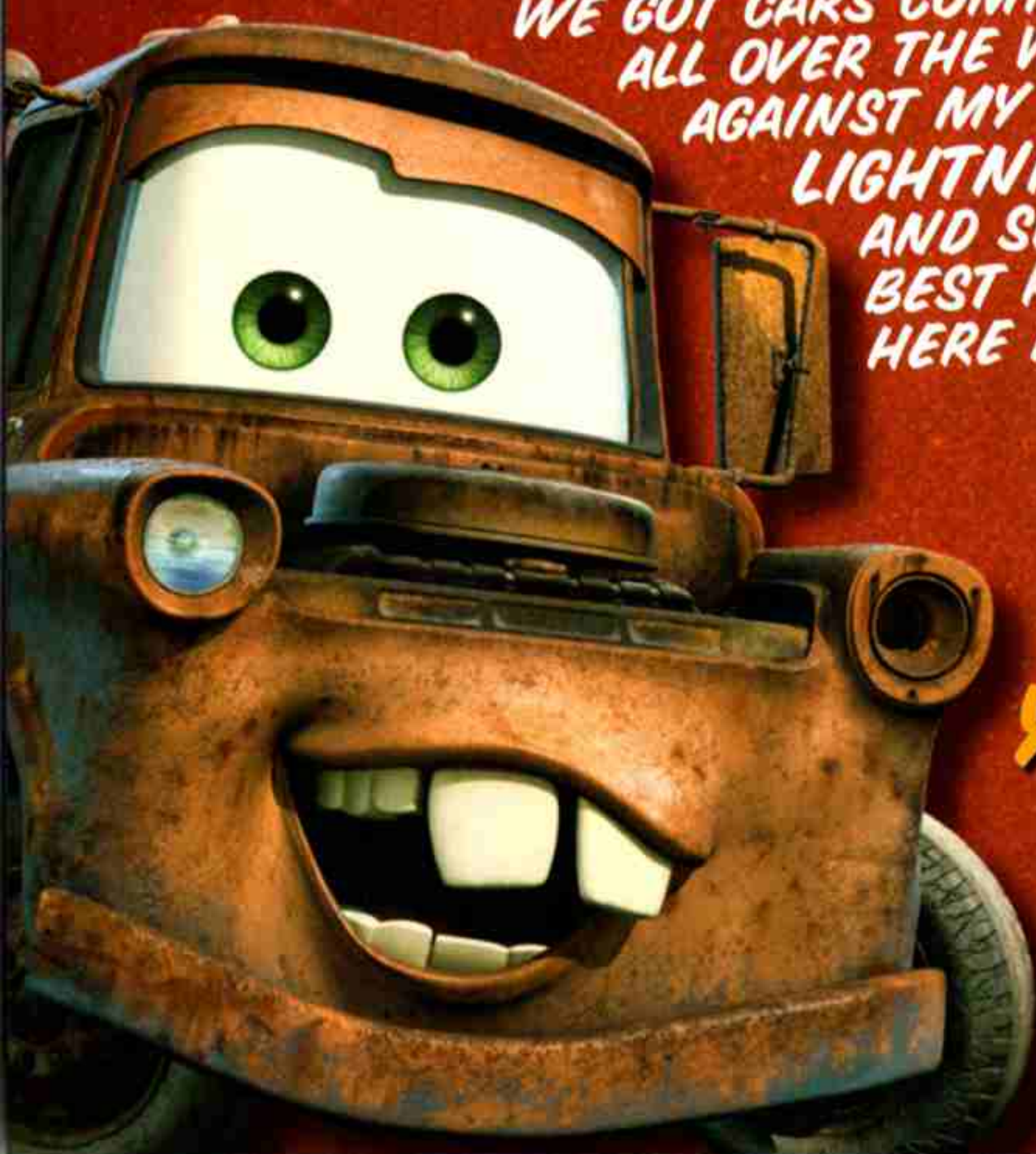
