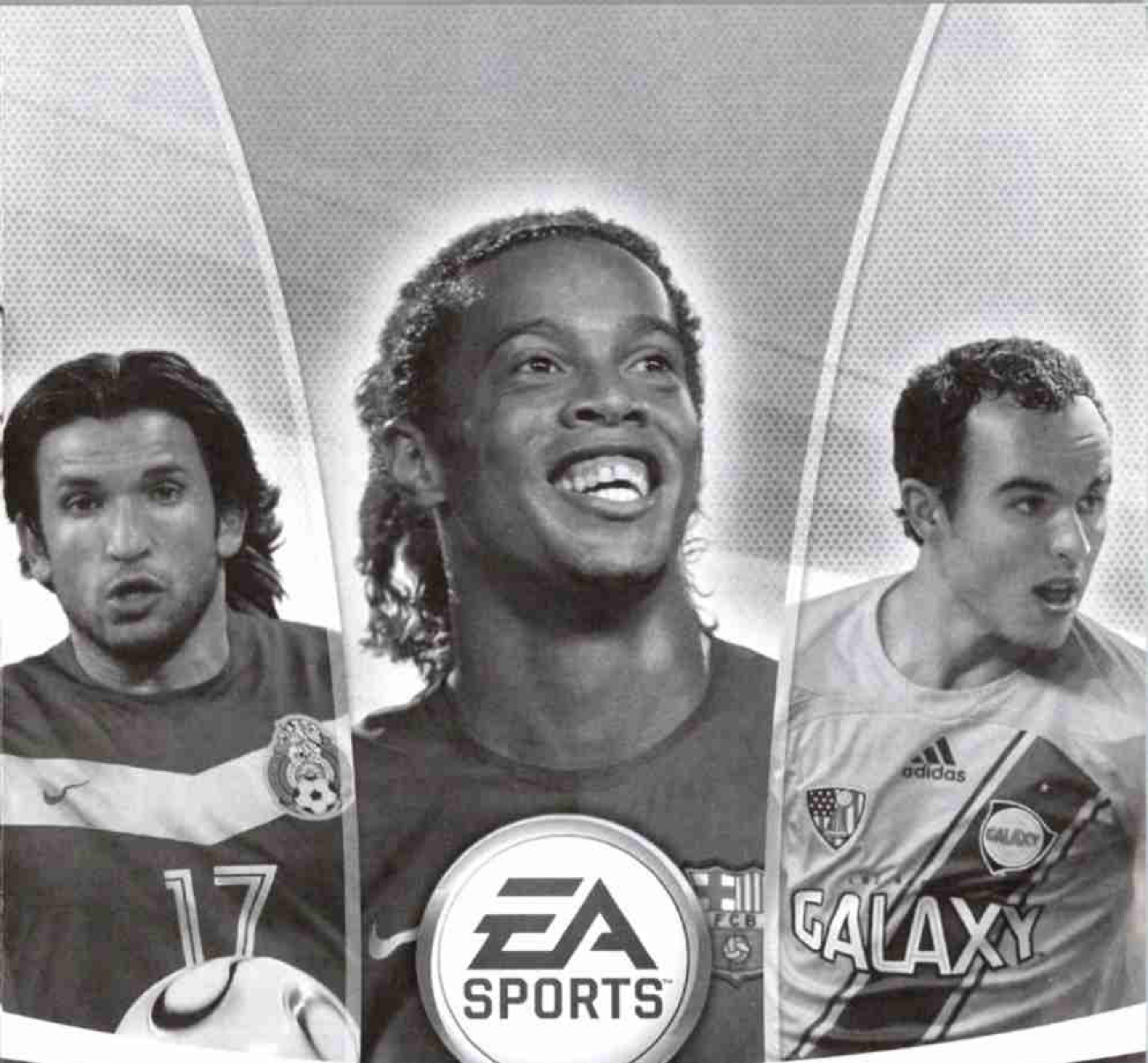

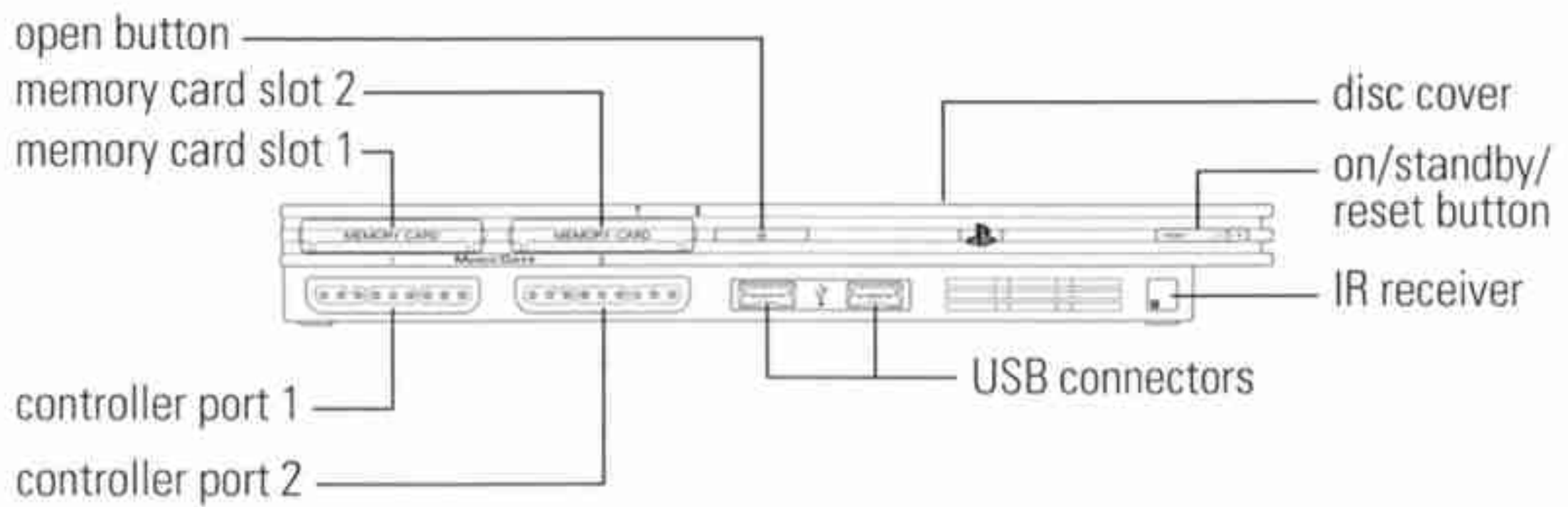

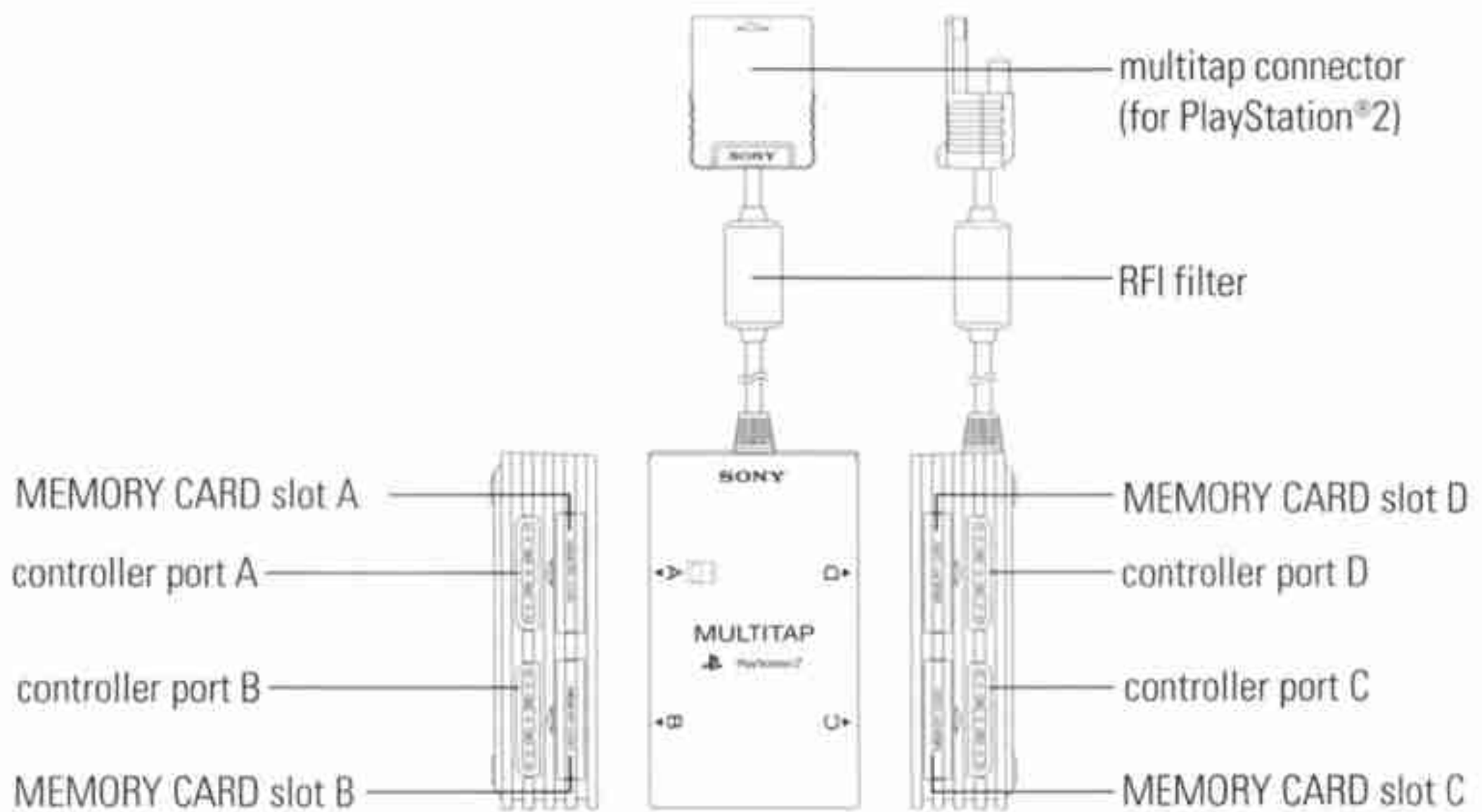

GETTING STARTED



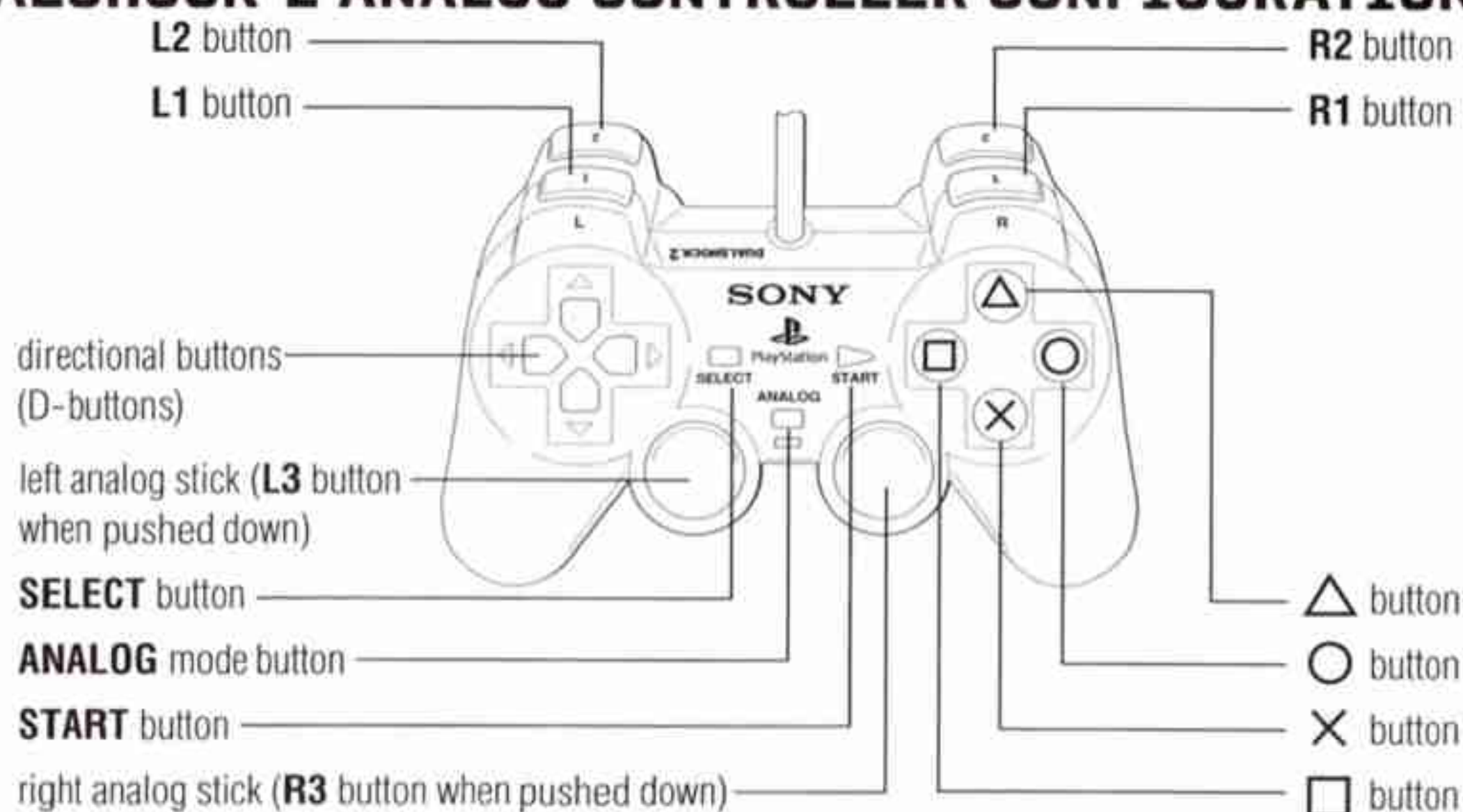
1. Set up your PlayStation®2 computer entertainment system according to the instructions supplied with your system.
2. Check that the system is turned on (the on/standby indicator is green).
3. Press the OPEN button to open the disc cover.
4. Place the *FIFA Soccer 07* disc with the label side facing up in the disc holder, and then close the disc cover.
5. Attach game controllers and other peripherals as appropriate.
6. Follow the on-screen instructions and refer to this manual for information on using the software.

NOTE: When using the multitap (for PlayStation®2), a controller must be connected to controller port 1-A.



STARTING UP

ADVANCED CONTROLS

ATTACKING

DRIBBLING

Stop the ball	left analog stick (release) + R1 button
Stop the ball (facing the goal)	left analog stick (release) + R2 button
Pace control	R2 button
Forward run	L1 button
First Touch	right analog stick (when receiving the ball)
Cancel trap	R2 button (hold) + L2 button
Knock on	right analog stick (while sprinting)
Dummy	L2 button (tap before receiving the ball)
Fake shot/cross/lob	× button (while powering a shot, cross, or lob)

NOTE: The longer you press and hold the right analog stick during a First Touch the further the ball travels.

PASSING

SHOOTING

Shooting in *FIFA Soccer 07* is more sophisticated than ever before. The key is to keep your composure and not take a shot too early. Be sure to find space to control the ball first so you don't overpower your shot and blast it into the stands.

TRICKS

Press the right analog stick to perform skill moves while standing or running.

NOTE: Trick controls are relative to the direction the player is facing on the pitch.

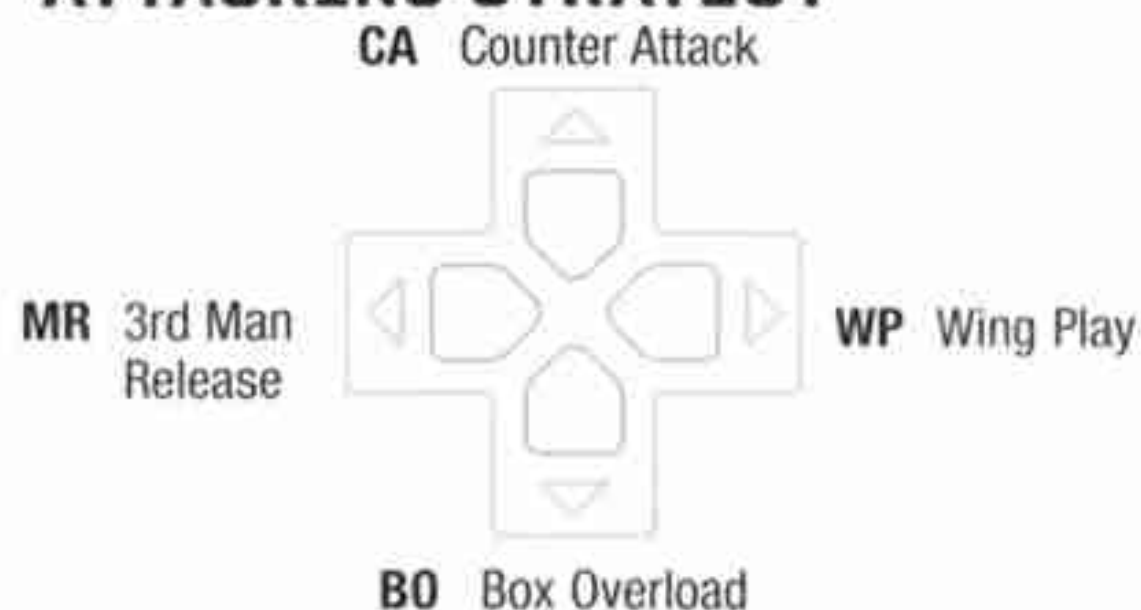

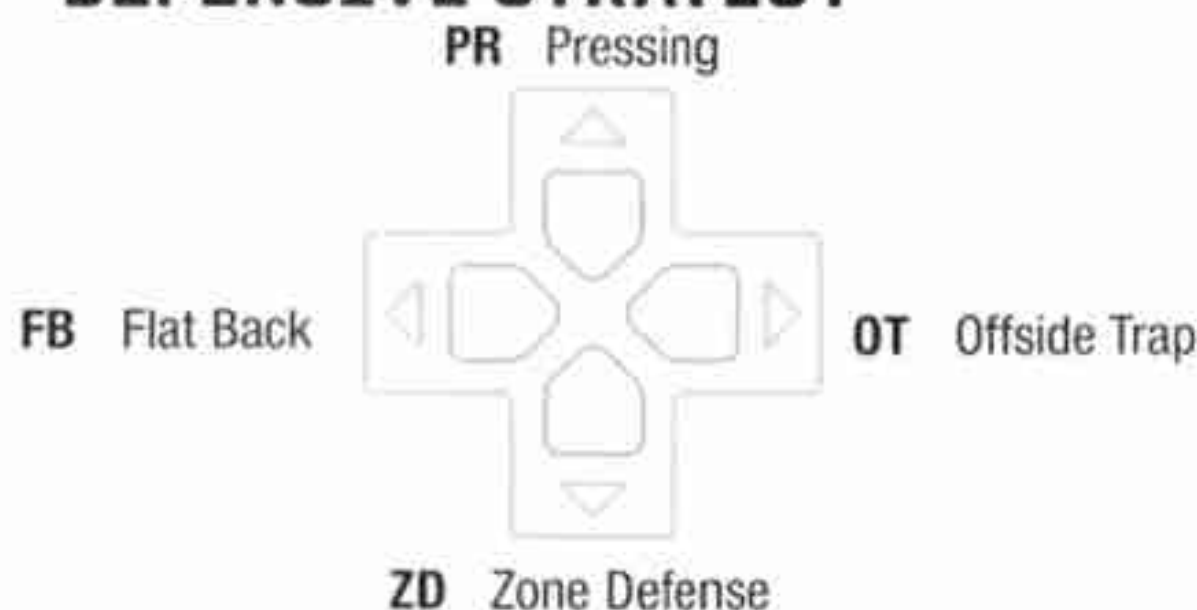
TACTICS AND MENTALITY

Press the D-button to make tactical adjustments to your team's attack during the game or press the L1 button + the D-button to change your defense:

ATTACKING STRATEGY



DEFENSIVE STRATEGY



Press the **SELECT** button to show the current Team Mentality, then press the **SELECT** button again to cycle through the mentalities (Neutral/All-Out Attack/Defensive).

NOTE: Access the My FIFA 07 menu and select TACTICS HELP/TIPS & HINTS for more information.

SET PIECES

TAKING A FREE KICK

In order to hit the target you need to follow these steps:

1. Press the left analog stick ←/→ to place your shot.
2. Press the **R1** button to change the kicker. Use the indicator to choose the ideal player to curl one in the corner, go for a quick pass, or lob one into the goal.
3. Take one of the following kicks: shot (Ⓢ button), driven shot (**L1** button + Ⓢ button), short pass (ⓧ button), or lob pass (Ⓜ button).

FREE KICK ADVANCED CONTROLS

Ball spin While powering the kick, press the left analog stick to add sidespin, topspin, or backspin.

Fake shot Press and hold the **L2** button and press any button to fake a shot.

Lay-off man Press and hold the **R2** button to call a teammate to roll the ball to you.

NOTE: The lay-off man gives you more options; press and hold the **R2** button and press the shot or lob button (Ⓢ button/Ⓜ button) to use the lay-off man to take the set piece. You can also press and hold the **R2** button and press the ⓧ button to lay off the ball for the primary kicker to take a shot.

SETTING UP THE GAME

KICK OFF

Get straight onto the pitch and take on any club or country in the game.

NEW ONLINE EVERYWHERE

Catch up on the latest scores and news for your favorite leagues every time you play *FIFA Soccer 07*. Wherever you are in *FIFA Soccer 07*, the ticker shows live scores and news. Plus, when you are signed onto Online Everywhere, you can listen to podcasts about soccer and Interactive Leagues.

- To enable Online Everywhere and sign in automatically when *FIFA Soccer 07* loads, select YES at the prompt to enable Silent Login. You must have a Your Network Configuration file set up on your memory card (8MB) (for PlayStation®2) and a valid EA account in order for Silent Login to work (see p. 9 for instructions on setting up your online functionality).

NOTE: Cycle through to Online Everywhere settings from the Game Settings screen to change your options.

SQUAD UPDATE

The Squad Update feature makes sure your teams are up-to-date with the latest signings, from transfers following the August 2006 and January 2007 transfer windows to the newest starting lineups, formations, and tactics.

- To update your squads, select INTERACTIVE LEAGUES from the Main menu or PLAY ONLINE from the Game Modes menu and go online. The Squad Update starts automatically. To save the update, select YES at the prompt when exiting your online game.

NOTE: You must have the latest squads to play online (see p. 9).

PLAYING THE GAME

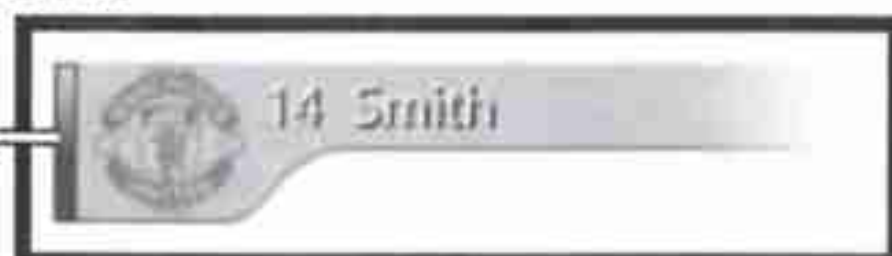

PLAYER STATUS BAR

Fitness level



During a match, the Player Status Bar appears at the bottom of the screen, displaying the highlighted player's current level of fitness. This level decreases the more a player sprints (press and hold the **R1** button), slowing him down, but replenishes when he returns to normal pace.

PERFORMANCE METER



The Performance Meter increases as the team gains momentum.

Keep one eye on the game and the other on the Performance Meter to check that the momentum stays with your team.

SAVING AND LOADING

SAVING

- To save files, choose the SAVE option from the relevant mode menu. You are also prompted to save files when exiting certain screens.

NOTE: A memory card in MEMORY CARD slot 1 is required to save data.

NOTE: Changes made outside individual game modes are applied to all game modes. Changes made within game modes are specific to that competition (except Game Settings).

LOADING

- To load previously saved files, select LOAD from the Main menu screen. Select a file and press the  button to load it.

GAME MODES

NOTE: Most of the game modes in *FIFA Soccer 07* are self explanatory and are not covered in this manual. Exceptions are listed below.

NEW EA SPORTS™ INTERACTIVE LEAGUES

Represent your club online throughout the season, playing the same matches as the real-life teams. Your results—combined with the results of other fans—determine whether your club rises to the top of their Interactive League or plummets into the relegation zone.

Support your club online—play as your club against fans of opponent clubs with one overall, cross-platform table for each supported league (The F.A. Premier League, French Ligue 1 Orange, German Bundesliga 1, and Mexican 1st Division). Build a community and help your favorite club towards the ultimate goal of topping the table.

REAL FIXTURES—THEY PLAY, YOU PLAY

Whenever your club has a real-world league fixture, you play online matches against fans of your club's opponent during a two day window leading up to the real match. Play as many matches as you can in the window leading up to the real fixture.

ONLINE COMMUNITY—THE FANS ARE THE CLUB

When you join a club, you join a community. Play together for a common goal. See how many other players support your club and how many are online. Visit the League Lobby Room to chat with fellow supporters or arrange matches with opponents.

ONE TABLE—WIN TOGETHER, LOSE TOGETHER

Every time you win an Interactive Leagues match, it counts as one vote for your club in the fixture. When the play window for the fixture closes, the club with the most votes gets the victory and the three points in the table. The effort and skill of all the supporters determines your club's fate.

PICKING A CLUB

Choose one club per league to represent online—support the team closest to your heart as well as teams in leagues less well known. If you pick a less-supported club, you will have more opponents to match up against and more opportunity to play.

YOUR CLUB

- Each club has a leaderboard listing the top 100 players' contribution to that club. Select TOP CLUB PLAYERS from the Interactive Leagues Main menu to view the players who have done the most. Can you be the best in your club?
- Select CHANGE CLUBS from the Interactive Leagues Main menu to switch clubs within a league. Only one change in a league is permitted during a season.

PLAYING A FIXTURE

The schedule for each league is set at the start of the season and matches the real-world fixtures. The schedule is updated only if matches are rescheduled. Only matches played in the Interactive Leagues mode count towards the tally of Interactive Leagues' fixtures.

- To play a fixture, select **PLAY SELECTED FIXTURE** on the Interactive Leagues Main menu. Otherwise, select **FIXTURE LIST** from the Interactive Leagues Main menu and select the game you want to play.

NOTE: In the Interactive Leagues, if the score is tied after 90 minutes, the match ends in a draw. This makes victories even more valuable.

PLAYING AGAINST RIVALS

What feels as good as winning for your club? Handing your rivals a loss. To make things a little more interesting in the Interactive Leagues, play your own club's fixtures *and* play against your club's rivals.

- When you select to play a fixture, choose **INCLUDE RIVAL FIXTURES**. The search for fixtures also includes matches where you play as the opponent of one of your club's rivals. This gives you even more opportunities to play—and that sweet satisfaction of sticking it to your rival.

MANAGER MODE

NEW PLAYER GROWTH

Nurture your players to become star performers through the new player growth system. Players need time on the pitch to build up experience and improve performance—growth is stunted by injuries and sitting it out on the bench. Consistently good match ratings for players over a season mean they fulfil their potential. Encourage their form with good coaching.

- Check the Match Facts after every game to monitor improvement. Press the **L1** button/**R1** button at the Match Facts screen to cycle through to the Player Growth statistics.
- The Match Experience gained is displayed along with their overall player level (OVR) and the match rating awarded (MR) for that game.
- Press the **○** button at the Match Facts screen to view individual player growth for that game.

NEW VISUAL SIM

Pull the strings, call the shots, and make all the tough decisions before watching the game from the sidelines. Choose **VISUAL SIM** from the Match Setup screen to watch a moment-by-moment summary of the game or **QUICK SIM** to run through the game immediately.

- Press the **⊗** button to take charge and play the match yourself.
- Press the **R2** button to switch between displaying statistics for momentum and possession on the pitch.
- Press the **START** button to pause the game and make changes to your side or formation.

NEW CURRENCY

Select the monetary value displayed throughout Manager mode by choosing one of three currencies—Euros, Dollars, or British Pounds—at the Create A Manager screen.

CREATE CLUB

Design a logo and kit, then pick the players for your created club. Select **ADD/REPLACE CLUB** on the Job Offers screen to import a created club into Manager mode.

PSP® [PLAYSTATION® PORTABLE] SYSTEM LINK

Play *FIFA Soccer 07* on the go by transferring your career files back and forth between your PSP® system and PlayStation®2.

NOTE: A USB cable is required to connect your PlayStation®2 to your PSP® system.

- Select **SAVE/PSP® LINK** in Manager Mode Central then select **EXPORT VIA PSP® LINK** to export your career to the PSP® system.
- Select **PSP® LINK** from the Game Modes menu to import your career from the PSP® system.

NOTE: See the *FIFA Soccer 07* PSP® system manual for instructions on setting up the PSP® system to transfer your career.

PLAY ONLINE

Take on opponents from around the globe via EA SPORTS™ Online.

A network adaptor (Ethernet/modem) (for PlayStation®2) and a memory card (8MB) (for PlayStation®2) with Your Network Configuration file inserted into MEMORY CARD slot 1 are required to play *FIFA Soccer 07* online. *FIFA Soccer 07* is compatible with Your Network Configuration files created from other PlayStation®2 online games. You can use the Network Adaptor Start-Up Disc that came with your network adaptor (Ethernet/modem) (for PlayStation®2) or the Network Configuration GUI in this game to create a network configuration. Your Network Configuration file requires 94KB of free space on the memory card (8MB) (for PlayStation®2).

PLAYING ONLINE

In order to play *FIFA Soccer 07* online, you must create a Your Network Configuration file and a new EA Account by following the on-screen instructions. If you already have an EA Account and a Network Configuration saved on a memory card, they appear automatically.

PLAYING BEHIND A FIREWALL

We recommend that you do not play behind a firewall. However, if you do wish to play behind a firewall, you must open the following UDP and TCP ports (both inbound and outbound): **TCP 13505** (EA Messenger), **UDP 9550** (Ticker), **TCP 30400-30499** (Gameplay), **UDP 3658** (Gameplay), and **UDP 6000** (VOIP).

HINTS AND TIPS

- **Passing**—Guide a pass in the direction you are facing for greater accuracy. When receiving a pass, move forward to intercept the ball earlier and avoid the tackle.
- **Star Players**—Some players' genius lies in ball control. Experiment with star players to get the best out of their game and see what tricks they can perform under pressure.
- **Secondary Defender**—For the defender nearest the ball, tackling isn't always the best form of defense. When facing the man in possession, it is sometimes more effective to block his route to goal and then call in a secondary defender (press the **L1** button) to make the challenge.
- **Keeper Quality**—The game's difficulty level determines how good your goalkeeper is (for both multiplayer and single player).
