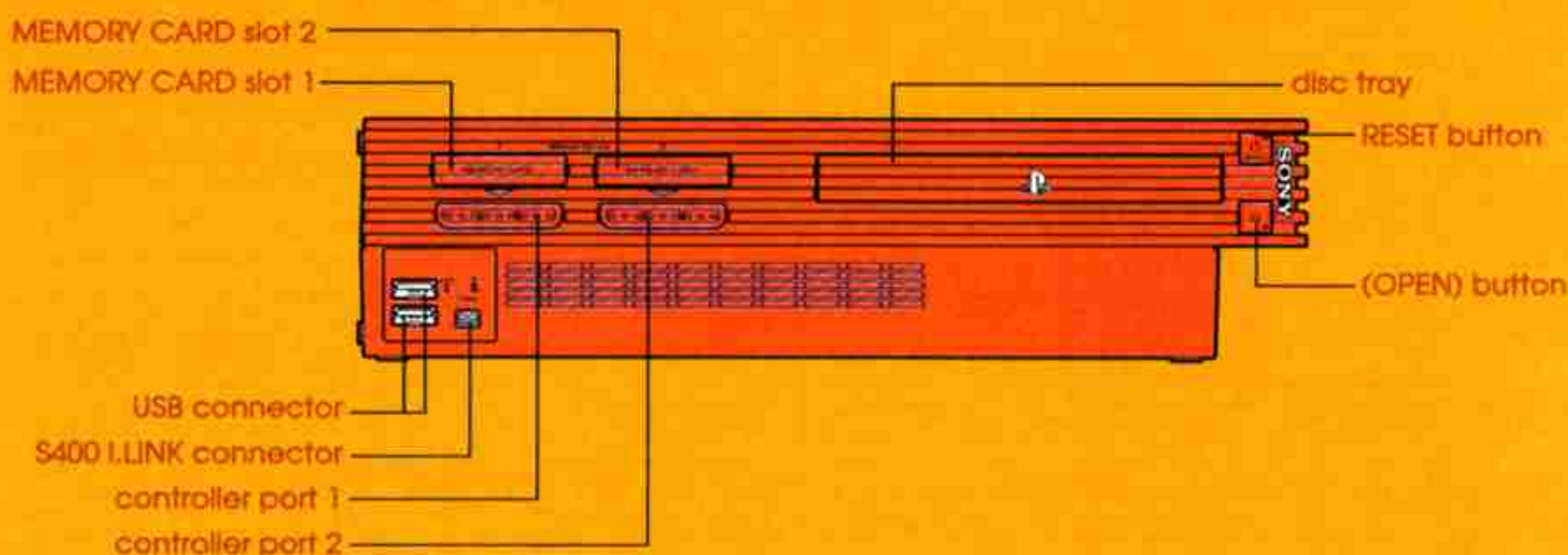

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GETTING STARTED

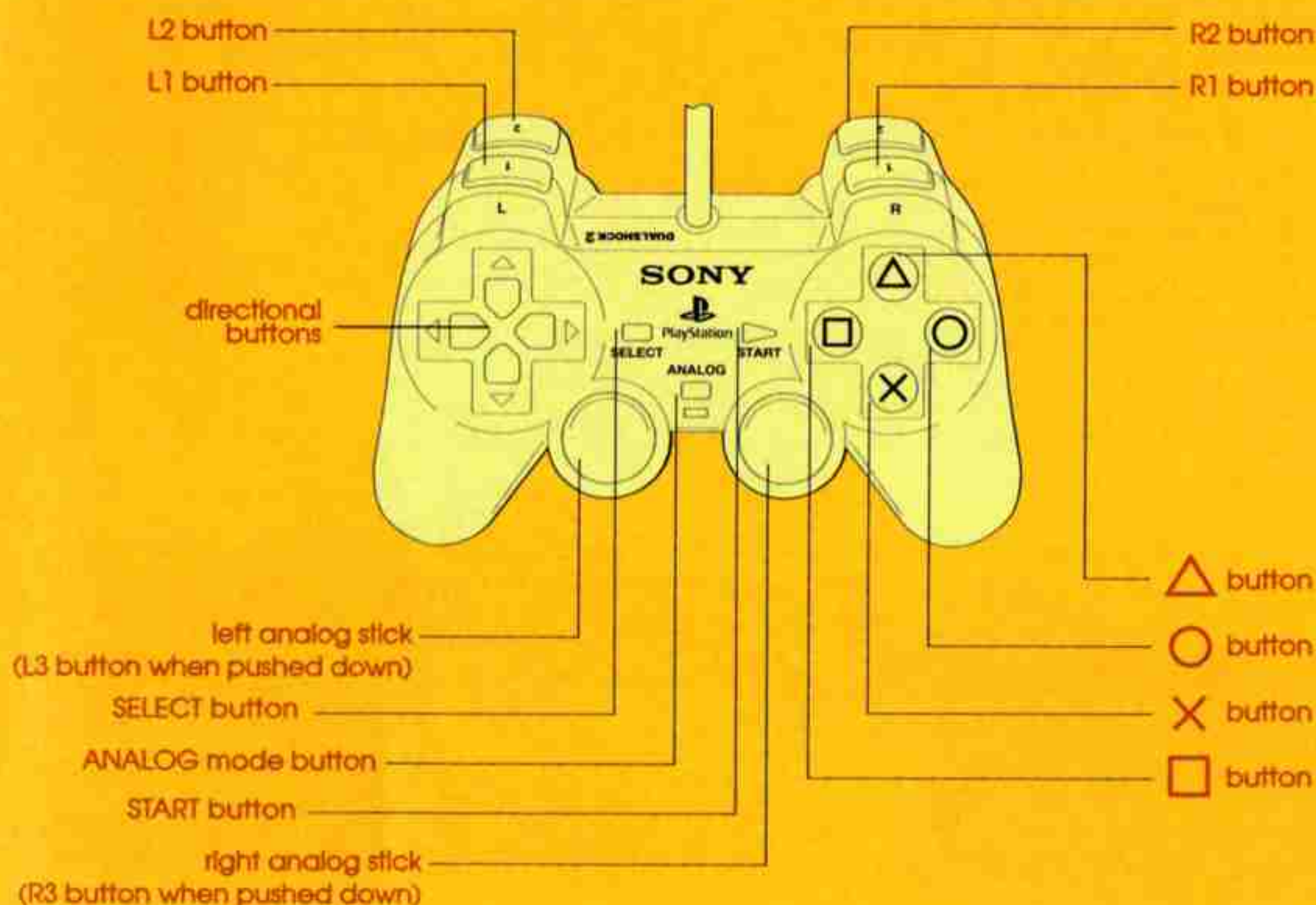


Set up your PlayStation®2 computer entertainment system according to the instructions in its Instruction Manual. Make sure the MAIN POWER switch (located on the back of the console) is turned on. Press the standby/RESET button. When the power indicator lights up, press the open button and the disc tray will open. Place the Grand Theft Auto: Vice City disc on the disc tray with the label side facing up. Press the open button again and the disc tray will close. Attach game controllers and other peripherals, as appropriate. Follow on-screen instructions and refer to this manual for information on using the software.

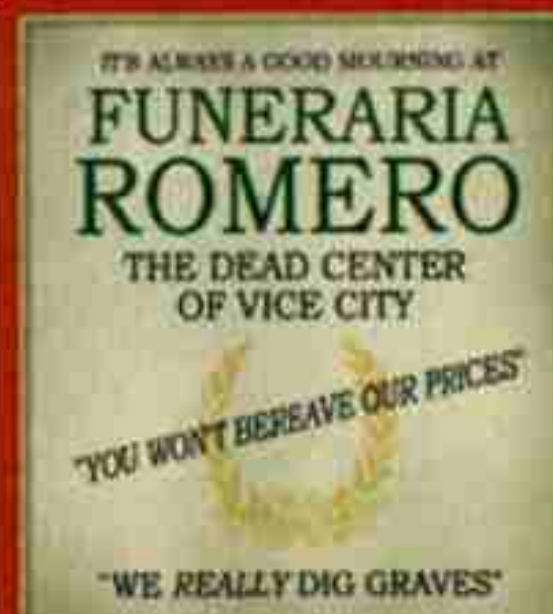
There is a strong military presence in Vice City with Fort Baxter Air Base located close to the airport.

Vice City Airport

Escobar International Airport is situated on the southwest side of town next to Fort Baxter Air Base and is easily reachable by road, although you will have to pass through Little Havana to get there.

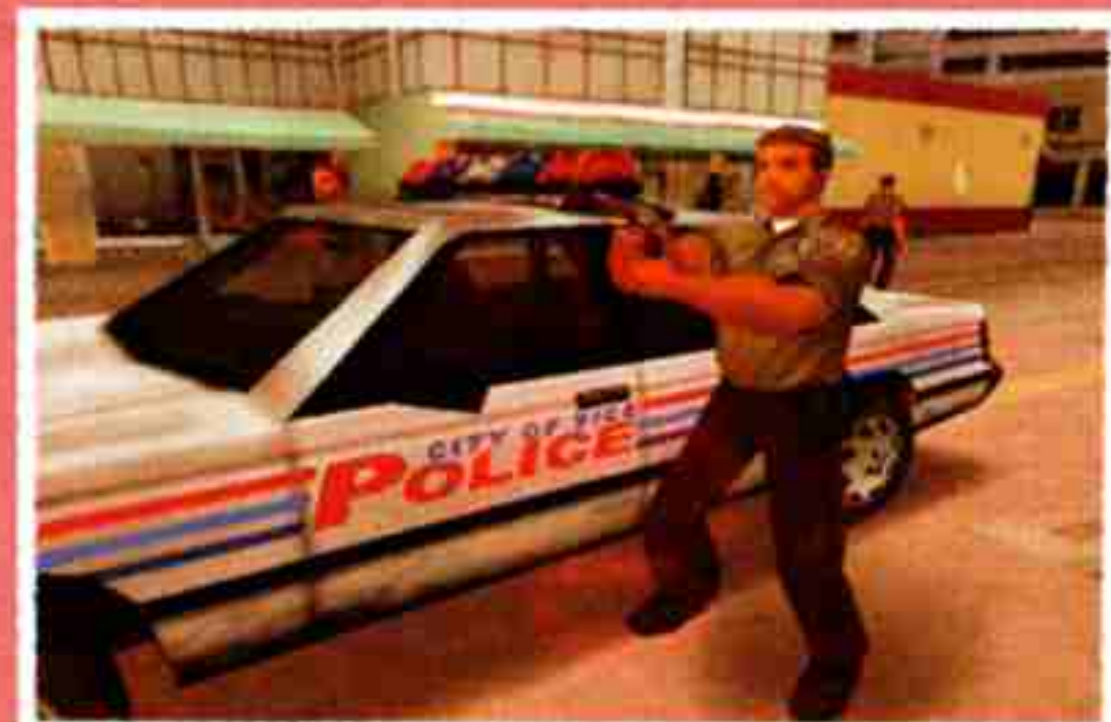

Personal Safety

Always carry a weapon ( button to fire, R1 button to target) Remember, you can only pack one weapon of each type at a time (one melee weapon, one handgun, etc). Press L1 button to replace your current selection with the new one, extra ammo will transfer right over.

Money

Carry a lot of it, always cash, it looks good. Besides that, you'll need it as there is plenty to spend your money on in Vice City. You can never have too many clothes, cars, mansions, or places to hide out.

Doing Business

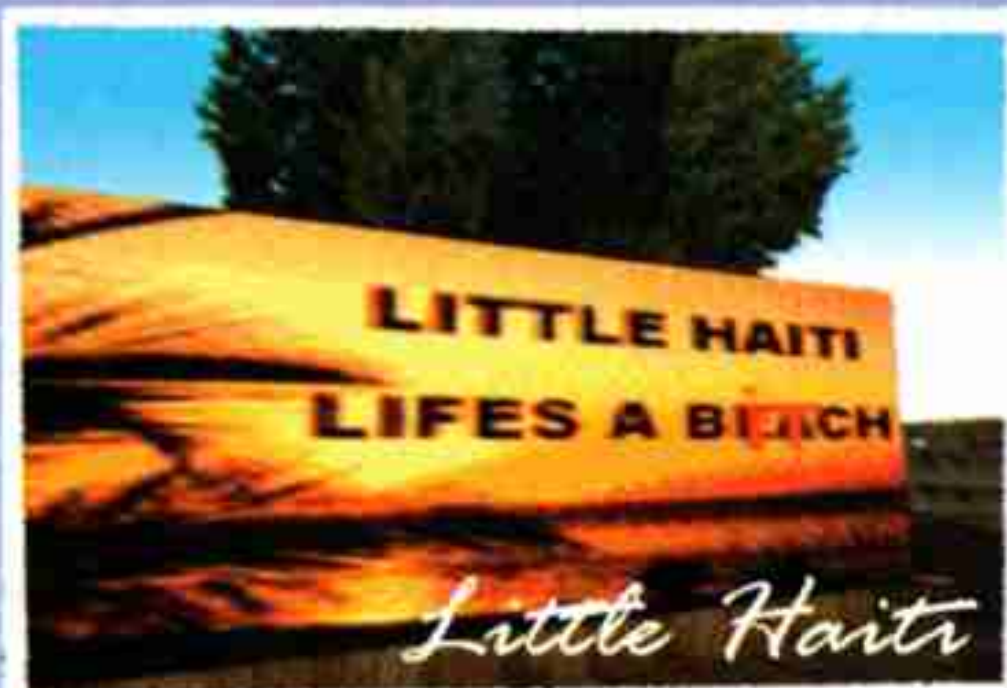

Shark attacks off Vice City happen a few times a year and there are more sharks out there than you would like to think – best advice: stay out of the water!



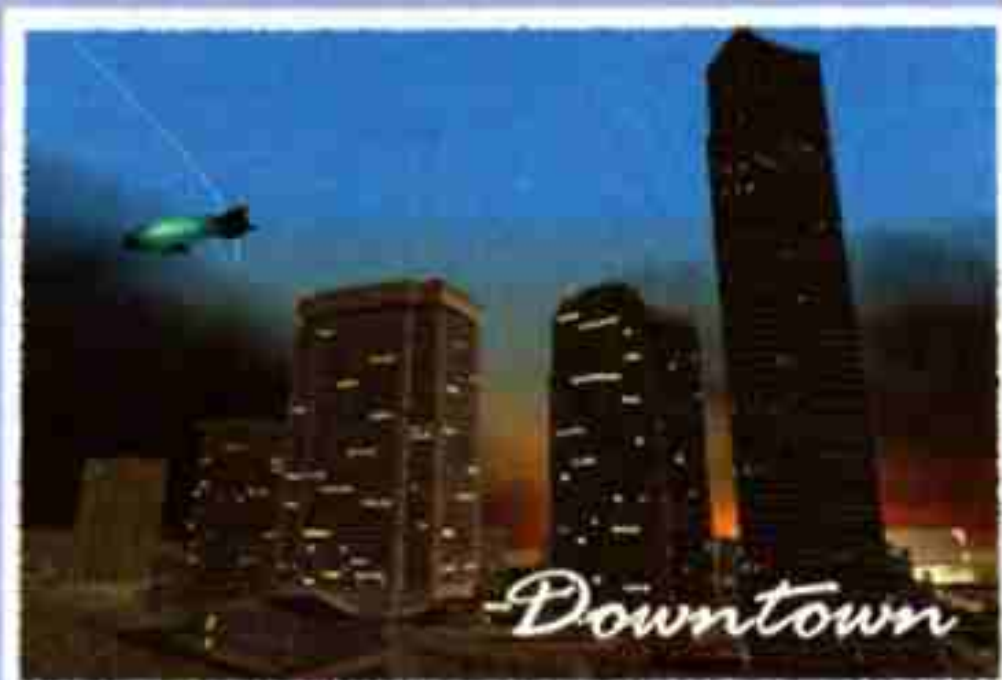
